# DISTRICT OF SECHELT Porpoise Bay Harbour Bylaw Amendment Bylaw No. 494-03, 2025

A bylaw to amend the Porpoise Bay Harbour Regulation Bylaw No. 494, 2010

**WHEREAS** Council of the District of Sechelt is Harbour Authority for the Porpoise Bay Harbour Government wharf and facilities under lease agreement between the District of Sechelt and His Majesty the King, in right of Canada as represented by the Minister of Fisheries and Oceans and acting through the Regional Director; and

**AND WHEREAS** Council of the District of Sechelt deems it expedient to adopt appropriate regulations for the use of the leased Porpoise Bay Harbour Government Wharf and facilities;

**NOW THEREFORE,** the Council of the District of Sechelt in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

#### TITLE

1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as, "Porpoise Bay Harbour Regulation Amendment Bylaw No. 494-03, 2025".

### **AMENDMENTS**

2. That the following section be added to Schedule A of the Porpoise Bay Harbour Regulation Bylaw No. 494, 2010:

### 12. Penalties and Enforcement

- a) Harbour customers and users who violate the regulations and provisions of this bylaw are subject to enforcement under the Bylaw Notice Enforcement Implementation Bylaw No. 515, 2012, and its amendments;
- b) Harbour customers and users who violate the regulations and provisions of this bylaw are subject to enforcement under the Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw No. 491, 2010, and its amendments.

#### **DEFINITIONS**

3. In this bylaw:

**Council** means the Municipal Council of the District of Sechelt.

## **PROVISIONS**

4. If any section, subsection or clause of this bylaw is for any reason held to be invalid by the decision of a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this bylaw.
