RECOMMENDATION

That Sewer Fees Amendment Bylaw 426-20, 2025 be considered for first, second and third readings.

PURPOSE

That the Sewer Fees Amendment Bylaw 426-20, 2025 be read a first, second and third time to increase the sewer user fee rates by 3.95 percent from 2024 rates.

DISCUSSION

Summary

Included in the 2025 Five-Year Financial Plan is a proposed 3.95 percent increase to sewer rates. The sewer budget includes operational expenses and capital projects that need to be completed in 2025.

The parcel tax will remain the same as 2024 at \$274. Included in the 2025 budget are capital projects valued at over \$1.22 million dollars. The capital projects will be funded from capital reserves.

POLICY AND BYLAW IMPLICATIONS

<u>Council Policy - 2.1.12 – User Fees & Charges</u>: Sewer fees would be categorized as full cost recovery by the Policy: "Full Cost Recovery is where the District determines that a service or good or access to a facility provided by the District provides a direct benefit to individuals, groups of individuals or businesses, a user fee or charge will be imposed to recover the full cost of providing the service, good or access to facility."

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The proposed sewer user fee would increase rates by \$26.85 per residence and \$56.50 for commercial properties with less than 10 employees, compared to 2024 rates.
