

DISTRICT OF SECHELT
Bylaw No. 456-04, 2025

A bylaw to amend the District of Sechelt Sign Bylaw No. 456, 2006

WHEREAS pursuant to Sections 8(4) and 65 of the *Community Charter*, the Council of the District of Sechelt may regulate the erection, placing, alteration, maintenance, demolition and removal of *signs*, sign boards, advertisements, advertising devices and structures;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the District of Sechelt wishes to:

- preserve and enhance the character of Sechelt’s aesthetic environment;
- allow for adequate and effective signs in all zones, while preventing signs from dominating the appearance of any area;
- ensure that signs are designed, constructed, installed and maintained so that public safety and traffic are not compromised

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Sechelt in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

TITLE

1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as, “Sign Amendment Bylaw No. 456-04, 2025”.

AMENDMENTS

2. The title of District of Sechelt Sign Bylaw No. 446, 2006, be updated to remove “District of Sechelt” for citation purposes.
3. The provision under Section 21 is deleted and replaced with:
 - a) Any person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is subject to fines under the Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw No. 491, 2010, and its amendments;
 - b) Any person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is subject to Bylaw Notice under the Bylaw Notice Enforcement Implementation Bylaw No. 515, 2012, and its amendments.

DEFINITIONS

4. In this bylaw:

Council means the Municipal Council of the District of Sechelt.

District means the municipal corporation of the District of Sechelt.

PROVISIONS

5. If any section, subsection or clause of this bylaw is for any reason held to be invalid by the decision of a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this bylaw.
